Per the Guidelines, *“The fellow must participate as a primary surgeon or direct assistant in 125 or more major facial cosmetic procedures during the Program. The Academy will review and monitor the number and type of procedures performed by the fellow to ensure there is an appropriate distribution among the cosmetic surgery procedures. At a minimum, the training fellow must participate in at least 20 Blepharoplasties, 15 Rhytidectomies, and 15 Rhinoplasties. The remaining procedures should include, brow lifts, treatment of skin lesions, skin resurfacing, cheiloplasty, genioplasty, liposuction, otoplasty, hard and soft tissue augmentation contour procedures, chemical peel, hair transplantation, dermabrasion, fat transfer, facial implants, and cosmetic laser procedure epidemiology. Instruction in the basic sciences, anatomy, anesthesia, ethics, pre-and postoperative management, surgical technique, wound healing, and laboratory technique. medicolegal and regulatory issues and quality assurance should be included in the curriculum;”*

If there is a shortfall in a particular type of case, please include a short explanation of how the Training Fellow will meet the program standards. If the deficiency will be made up by your faculty, include a summary case listing for them as well. The faculty case listing can be uploaded in the additional supporting documents form field.
