



E. GAYLON MCCOLLOUGH, MD

*The Genesis and Future of The American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery*


Dr. E. Gaylon McCollough has obtained international recognition as a surgeon and teacher. Dr. McCollough, who runs a 35,000-square-foot practice in Gulf Shores, Alabama, is the co-author of several textbooks and books on facial and nasal plastic surgery. Dr. McCollough completed an approved program of specialized training in facial plastic surgery in Beverly Hills, New Orleans and Boston. He is board-certified by The American Board of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery and has served as the Board's President. He also is Founder and President of the American College of Rejuvenology. He was elected President of the International Council of Integrative Medicine and has traveled the world to teach seminars and techniques on head and neck plastic surgery.



PETER P. RULLAN, MD

*Chemical Peels for the Treatment of Melasma, Acne Scars, and Photoaging: A 26-Year Retrospective*

Dr. Peter Rullan has been in private practice in Chula Vista, California since 1983. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery with special certification in Dermatologic Surgery. Dr. Rullan is a Fellow of the American Academy of Dermatology and of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery. He is Past-President of the San Diego Dermatologic Surgical and Medical Societies. His areas of special interests and training include the treatment of Acne and Psoriasis, Chemical Peels for Acne Scars, Skin Rejuvenation and Pigmentation, Tumescant Liposuction and Lipotransfer, Skin Cancer Treatment with Mohs Surgery and Reconstruction and Sclerotherapy of Spider and Varicose Veins.



JULIE WOODWARD, MD

*Handling and Preventing Risk Management Issues of Oculofacial Surgery*

Dr. Julie Woodward is the chief of oculofacial surgery at the Duke University Medical Center in Durham, North Carolina. She specializes in surgery of the eyelids and orbit, as well as cosmetic laser surgery of the skin. Dr. Woodward completed a fellowship in oculofacial surgery with Dr. Sterling Baker, MD, who is credited with the invention of the CO2 laser blepharoplasty. She's now a fellow of the American Society of Ophthalmic Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery and Women's Dermatologic Society. Her aesthetic research interests are in fractional laser resurfacing, injectable fillers, neurotoxins and eyelash growth. She has written numerous textbook chapters on techniques of incisional laser surgery and is the director of the aesthetic laser surgery course at the American Academy of Ophthalmology.



KOTARO YOSHIMURA, MD

*Adipose Stem/Progenitor Cells: Physiological Functions and Clinical Potentials for Soft Tissue Augmentation*

Dr. Yoshimura is an Associate Professor in the Department of Plastic Surgery at the University of Tokyo in Japan. He is also a Visiting Professor at several universities such as the Division of Plastic Surgery, University of California Davis. He is a renowned cosmetic surgeon-scientist who has worked around the globe to share his research expertise including stem cell technology.






